- 4 one subject wide ruled notebooks (red, yellow, green, purple)
- ½ inch binder
- 3 twenty-four count Crayola crayons
- 2 yellow highlighters
- 4 glue sticks
- 3 boxes of twelve count Dixon Ticonderoga #2 sharpened pencils
- 1 pair *Fiskars for Kids* scissors (*Blunt tip*)\

SUMMER READING 2016 for Incoming 2nd Graders

Research has shown over and over again that the best thing students can do to become better readers is to **READ**. Reading builds fluency, improves comprehension skills, increases vocabulary and builds background knowledge. It is also a wonderful way to relax and develop imagination. Therefore, in order to help our students continue to progress in their reading, we encourage everyone continue to read over the summer. Read to your child, read with your child and have your child read by him or herself.

We would like all incoming 2nd graders to read a minimum of 6 books over the summer. Two of the books can be read to or with your child. Please have your child keep a written list of the books he or she reads. (See attached forms). In addition, your child needs to pick one of the books to write about on the attached book report form.

On the back is a suggested, ***but not limited to***, summer reading list for children entering second grade. We highly encourage you to bring your children to the Sheppard Memorial Library, the East Branch, Winterville Branch or other branches to find books that interest your child. They have a wonderful summer reading program which includes fun incentives for the children to read.
